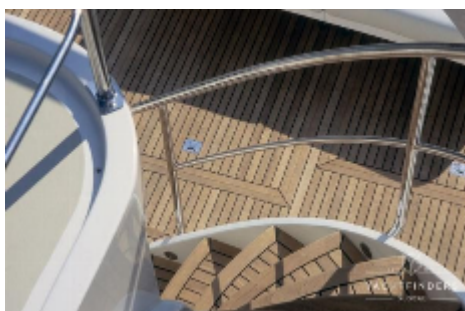


Grand Banks 47 2005
