

Lagoon 450– Owner's Version – 2013



This Lagoon 450 Owner's Version is a 3-cabin layout catamaran designed for comfortable long-term cruising, featuring full air conditioning and a lithium battery system. Lightly used by a single owner, the boat presents in good condition and benefits from a strong level of equipment for autonomy and liveaboard comfort, making her an ideal choice for private ownership or extended cruising plans.

INTERIOR & COMFORT

The Owner's Version layout offers a spacious and practical configuration, with a large owner's hull to starboard and two guest cabins with ensuite bathrooms to port. The saloon is bright and welcoming, with a U-shaped galley, navigation station, and dining area. The interior condition reflects careful ownership, with only one owner since new and light use in recent years. The cockpit is equally inviting, featuring custom aqua-blue upholstery and a folding teak table ideal for entertaining. A high-end galley setup (induction cooktop, steam oven, dishwasher, washing machine) and full air conditioning ensure excellent onboard comfort.

This is one of the first Lagoon 450s equipped with an in-boom furling mainsail, serviced in April 2026 alongside a full rigging survey. The sail inventory is comprehensive and versatile, including genoa, parasailor, gennaker, and storm jib, allowing safe and efficient sailing in all conditions. The flybridge configuration remains one of the most sought-after layouts, offering excellent visibility and handling for short-handed crews.

ENGINES & MECHANICAL

Powered by Yanmar engines (approx. 1,500 hours) with electronic control at the helm station, and a full engine service in June 2026. The generator has been fully serviced, and general maintenance has been carried out across key systems, including air conditioning and toilets, ensuring the vessel is ready for her next owner.

ELECTRONICS & COMMUNICATION

The yacht is fitted with a complete Furuno electronics suite at the flybridge, including a 15" chartplotter, radar, and AIS, ensuring safe and efficient navigation.

The anchoring system is robust and designed for serious cruising, featuring a Quick windlass with chain counter and helm controls, paired with 120m of stainless steel chain and a 40kg stainless anchor. The Walkerbay 325 centre-console tender with 30HP outboard (serviced) provides comfortable shore access.

HIGHLIGHTS

This Lagoon 450 stands out for its single ownership, very good overall condition, and extensive recent maintenance program completed specifically in preparation for sale. Combined with a recent price reduction, she represents a strong opportunity for buyers looking for a well-equipped, proven cruising catamaran.

A shortlist of improvements would bring the boat to an excellent turnkey standard for bluewater cruising.
