This boat was purchased from Osprey in 2012 and shipped to the North Island for fitting. It has generally been used in the Hauraki Gulf. On average, she has only seen between 15 and 20 sea days, averaging 50 to 60 hours of outboard time per year. It comes with a trailer which has been recently serviced and has a current WOF. **SERVICE & MAINTENANCE HISTORY:** Has been regularly serviced every 100 hours, including its 10-year service, during which both fuel tanks were removed and pressure-tested, and minor leaks were addressed.
